FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

I'm going out of town and won't be able to shop for my senior. What should I do?

If you are going out of town contact the volunteer coordinator as soon as you're aware of your travel plans. This allows time for the coordinator to find coverage while you're away. If possible, we recommend trying to accommodate the client first because this summer it will be more challenging to find a substitute shopper. Additionally, if you will be traveling to a state that requires you to quarantine when you return from your travels, please make the coordinator aware of this as well so they can find additional coverage during your quarantine.
